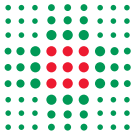

WHY TAKE PART?

- The earlier the diagnosis, **the more effective and less invasive** treatments will be
- Bowel and cervical lesions can be identified and treated when they are still precancerous, **preventing them from developing into tumours**
- Screening examinations are performed by **experienced, qualified staff** with equipment compliant with the relevant standards
- Procedures are **completely free of charge**, as are any further investigations required

WHO IS IT FOR?

Everyone with health service cover resident and domiciled in the Province of Modena.

The target groups are:

- **for BOWEL CANCER screening**
men and women aged from 50 to 74.
When? Every 2 years
- **for BREAST CANCER screening**
women aged from 45 to 74.
When? Every year for 45-49 and every two years for 50-74 age-ranges
- **for CERVICAL CANCER screening**
PAP TEST every 3 years for 25-29 and
HPV TEST every 5 years for 30-64 age-ranges

HOW DO YOU TAKE PART?

People in the relevant age-ranges will receive an individual letter with the date, time and place where they can attend for their screening examination.

For bowel cancer screening, the letter will contain a faeces sampling kit with test tube, complete with instructions for specimen preparation and delivery.
