

Progetto RI-SO

The RI-SO project aims to early intercept social withdrawal in boys and girls aged between 11 and 19 years, residing in the province of Modena.

Social withdrawal is a phenomenon affecting adolescents who gradually reduce their friendship, social activities, and school attendance, ending up confined at home or in their room.

Contact with the outside world is maintained through gaming and social media.

The project offers consultations to parents, teachers, educators, and healthcare professionals who encounter at risk situations:

- helps to understand what is happening
- supports the search for strategies to develop existing resources and to counteract the progression of social withdrawal
